PURPOSE OF THE FESTIVAL

Kuldleheke is a competition-festival for vocal soloists organized by NGO Kuldleheke in cooperation with Pärnu School of Arts. The competition takes place in the category of pop-jazz and classical singing, which is evaluated by an international jury of 3-5 members.

The festival is intended for children and young people, whose activities are related to the enrichment of competences in the field of interest.

We want to give the participants the opportunity to perform, gain experience, present themselves to the organizers of international competitions and offer a chance for a musical experience. Instructors have the opportunity to share practical and methodical work experiences. Through the festival, there is an opportunity to strengthen international ties and perform at concerts held in schools in the city of Pärnu.

REGULATION

Pop-jazz category

- One song will be performed at the competition, the length of the song must not exceed 4 minutes.
- Either one accompanying instrument or a phonogram can be used to accompany the song.
- It is allowed to use 1-2 background singers.
- The song selection can be changed no later than October 1, 2024, the request must be notified to the e-mail address kuldleheke@gmail.com.
- Up to two soloists can participate from each instructor in each age category.
- A total of 15 soloists can register for each age group.
- The organizer reserves the right to make changes in the number of participants.
- Age levels:
 - ✤ I age group: 7-9
 - ✤ II age group: 10 12
 - ✤ III age group: 13 15
 - ✤ IV age group: 16 18
 - ✤ V age group: 19 22
- The registration deadline is August 19, 2024.

Classical singing category

- Two songs will be performed at the competition one classical song of your choice and another classical song written by a composer from your country.
- A piano or some other acoustic instrument can be used to accompany the song.
- The performance is without amplification and phonograms are not allowed.
- A total of 10 soloists can register for each age group.
- The organizer reserves the right to make changes in the number of participants.
- Age levels:
 - ✤ I age group: 12 14
 - ✤ II age group: 15 17
 - ✤ III age group: 18 22
- Performance duration:
 - ◆ I age group up to 6 min.
 - ♦ II age group up to 8 min.
 - ♦ III age group up to 10 min.
- Sheet music deadline is September 1, 2024 at the latest.
- The registration deadline is August 19, 2024.

BASIS OF JURY WORK AND ASSESSMENT

- The participants are evaluated by an international jury, which assesses the interpretation, artistry, suitability of the song for the performer, purity of intonation, cooperation with the concertmaster.
- In all age groups, I III place and 3 laureates will be announced.
- The jury has the right to award special prizes.

- The Grand Prix is chosen at the finals of the competition, where the winners of all age groups perform their song again.
- In classical singing, the Grand Prix is awarded based on the jury's decision.

PARTICIPATION FEE

The participation fee in the pop-jazz category is $80 \in$, in the classical singing category $50\in$. If the participant takes part in both categories, the participation fee is $100 \in$. For the participant as a background singer, the fee is $30 \in$. A participant who takes part as a soloist does not have to pay a separate backing singer fee. There is an opportunity to use the organizer's concert master, an additional fee of $50 \in$. An additional fee for changing a track after October 1 is $10 \in$. Video recording of the performance is $15 \in$, link with photos $10 \in$. **The participation fee payment deadline is October 1, 2024.**
